We now have a recently renovated facility in the Community Center and invite you to come in for a visit to review our collection which currently contains over 3000 books. Every month we purchase most of the fiction Best Sellers, and at least five of the non-fiction Best Sellers, from the *New York Times* Sunday Books Section. We also buy books which a committee recommends from *Booklist*. We continue to increase our collection of LARGE PRINT books with new ones added regularly. In addition, we have a growing number of audio books on CD, as well as a large selection of DVDs available. We subscribe to the *Wall Street Journal* and *Consumer Reports*.

The Library is staffed by a large and active group of Volunteers. We are always looking for more – please stop in and ask for information about joining us or call our Volunteer Chairman.

We have initiated a service for any of our patrons who are unable to visit the library. “Ambassadors” will deliver books and CDs/DVDs to anyone who requests them – either short term or on a more permanent basis.

Membership in our Friends of the Library program helps finance some of our programs and supports our Used Book Sale in the fall. The annual donation of \$5.00 or more entitles the member to the Friday night wine and cheese preview and early purchase of books.
