### **New Business/Council Discussion Items**

 The Annual Budget Meeting planned for December 2, 2020 was cancelled due to the Coronavirus. The Council's Operating Budget and Capital information was presented by Mr. Fleming and reviewed by Council. A motion to approve the Budget by Mr. Worden and a second by Mr.DiGiuseppe was passed unanimously. #### Old Business Follow up

Stone wall restoration. A total of 59 walls have been examined. It is

power washing. Additional estimates will be obtained and it was decided
that the work will be put off until the Spring.
