Message from the President

This has been an active month for the board.

One situation that was dealt with was the requirement to raise the height of the berm around the main storm water retention pond and the reduction in size of the outlet pipe. This issue is one Hovnanian is responsible for, will be paying for and is expected to start the middle of August. They will erect a silt fence around the effected area starting August 11 and renewing their surveying of the work site. August 18, they will start moving topsoil from a staging area in the extra parking area near 1651 to the berm until they attain the proper height. Following their filling operation, they will sod the access area and seed the berm. This will take about a week, weather permitting. The sod and seed will be watered by the contractor until all is mature.

Falcon Engineering is being hired to obtain bids for the stucco repair work on units 1640, 1641, and 1642. Hopefully this work can be set to start in time to complete this work before winter this year.

The attorneys have asked us to retest units previously repaired to ensure the repairs were done correctly. These inspections are to start right away, if they aren't already done by the time this is distributed.

Mail box replacements are well under way to rave reviews. Many posts were badly deteriorated so this is great timing!

Planned post and rail fence repairs have been completed behind units 1624, 1684, 1686 and 1687.

Garage door and mantel painting should be started by the time you read this. New numbers are being "donated by our Social Committee-thank you! If you are unable to arrange to have doors opened during this operation, your door painting will be rescheduled in September.

Changing your emergency alarms to "digital" and replacement of all batteries is scheduled for September is being paid for by the HOA.

Driveway seal coating is scheduled to start in September.
