Message from the President

March is here and daffodils are about to bloom! The re-roofing project will start about the middle of the month delivering materials and equipment to be stored in the visitor parking areas closest to the West entrance. As they proceed through the Village, they will move their stuff to parking areas near to the homes they are working on. Your cooperation with this is essential to their progress.

Quarterly Assessments

Please remember that the new quarterly assessments, \$1,874, are due starting January 1. You should have received payment books and envelopes. The roofing assessments were due February 1. If you haven't paid your share, please do so.

Roof replacement project

The reroofing work will proceed fairly quickly, about a week or ten days per group but is subject to the weather. Before the work starts on your roof, you will be given a permit that must be taped to a window beside your front door. This will be replaced with a certificate of completion to replace the permit that must remain in the window until you are notified it can be removed-a requirement of East Goshen Township.

Don't forget to move your deck furniture as previously stated. If you are unable to, they will move it but are not responsible for any damage. Also, remove window screens. If you are unable to, they will assist you. During demolition, KPI will cover the windows with tarps.
