Repainting of the shutters will follow.

Landscape Committee

Hershey's Mill Landscaping (Cedarcrest) will begin be applying the 1st round of lawn fertilizer and pre-emergent crabgrass control in the MA areas and villages during the first two weeks of April. Signs will be posted at Yardley's entrances the day before they apply the fertilizer and weed control.

With the roofing project this year HML's mulch application is delayed until fall. If you plan on mulching yourself or are planning to use a contractor, please be sure to conform to the type of mulch used by HML in Yardley and throughout the Mill. Rubber mulches, cocoa shells, pine bark nuggets etc. are not to be used and the mulch must match the brown color used by HML.

Edging installed in Yardley should conform to the guidelines in the rules and regulations. "Border materials to be used are limited to natural stone in earth tones (flagstone, Belgian block, pavers, etc.) No wood, plastic or red bricks are to be used."
