The Master Association Board appreciates the feedback from the HMSG, however after due consideration at their meeting on September 25th, it was the consensus of the BOD that the policy should remain as adopted at the August 7th Board meeting.

The Board discussed how long and established this policy has been at the Community Center where residents and non-residents alike have contributed 10% of any monies collected for classes, clinics, bridge lessons, sale of paintings, etc. The Board also noted how a large number of individuals volunteer dozens and perhaps hundreds of hours through each and every year to make Hershey's Mill villages and amenities function smoothly, efficiently and for the good of all residents. It thus seems eminently fair and equitable that if select residents are able to generate some measure of compensation through the use of resident provided and maintained facilities, a 10% contribution back to the Association is in order.

The Board trusts that this will be understandable to the HMSG members.
