Good Afternoon,

There are plenty of baby wedges ready for priming and painting in the painting room. There are finished examples as well to show how the colors are placed. There are no specifics on colors; the wedges are going to be used for loan and not customized for a particular child. Some of the paint has primer so you do not need to prime first before painting if you see primer+paint on the label. For the rest, the pieces need to be primed first, followed by two coats of paint, then polyurethane. I believe the can of primer may still be at the wood shop. I will check on that.

Several rockers have also been completed. We are figuring out how to proceed with finishing and customizing those, details to follow.

I am aware of parties at Sullivan House 12/6 and 12/13 so the painting room may not be easily accessible at those times. Please feel free to reach out with any questions. I am happy to share that we have a volunteer to help to coordinate the group. Look for details on that as well.
