



Rules & Information

Patrons are responsible for understanding and following all rules!
The pool area is a non-smoking environment.

Pool Patron Policies

- Residents and guests must enter through the main gate, sign in, and register upon arrival.
 - No entry through the tennis gate.
 - Residents must use guest cards or pay a daily admission for each guest, even if only to sit.
 - Guest cards (15 punches) are \$35. 1 punch per guest on weekdays, 2 punches on weekends and holidays. Cards are good indefinitely.
 - Daily guest admission is \$4 on weekdays, \$6 on weekends and holidays.
 - Payment by checks preferable. Make payable to "Hershey's Mill Pool Fund."
 - Children are not permitted on Fridays.
 - Residents are responsible for supervising their guests at all times, including locker rooms, sports area, and the Cove.
 - If bringing more than 6 guests, as a courtesy to other residents, please notify the Pool Manager one day in advance.
 - Guests are not permitted to bring guests.
 - Adult/child ratio = 1 adult per 4 children

Health Rules

- Shower before using the pool. All long hair must be tied up.
 - Immediately report **all** injuries or medical situations to the lifeguard on duty. Emergency 911 will be contacted as necessary.
 - HM Security control all cases involving paramedic and ambulance service. A Pool Accident report must be completed in all cases.
 - See lifeguard for first aid. AED available in the Cove.
 - Anyone with draining infections of the skin, open wounds, or infectious respiratory tract disorders are not permitted in the pool. No bandaids.
 - Don't swim for 2 weeks after an episode of diarrhea.
 - No children in swim diapers or diapers/pull-ups are allowed in the pool. This includes children in "training pants", etc. Please take children to the bathroom frequently.
 - Baby pools not permitted.
 - If a resident or guest requires assistance into or out of the pool, he or she must make arrangements in advance for his or her assistance to be present and available to assist when needed.

Safety Rules

- Not permitted: glass of any kind, bicycles, skateboards, roller skates, or pets.
 - No swimming when lifeguard is not on duty.
 - No swimming in diving area when diving board is in use.
 - Diving from side of pool allowed only in diving area and when the diving board is not in use.
 - Only 1 person on the diving board at any time. No running on the diving board.
 - Lap lane is for swimming laps.
 - Food and beverages are permitted only in **non-glass** containers. Use trash or recycle containers.
 - To prevent lotions from ruining the chairs, place towels on chairs/lounges.
 - No wet suits in the Cove.
 - Respect other bathers when using cell phones.

Kid Friendly Rules

- Adults must monitor young guests (**under 14**) in the Cove, bathrooms, pool, and sports facilities.
 - Adult-only swim **may** be called at 3 p.m. All children must clear the entire pool for 30 minutes.
 - Young children must be potty-trained. No diapers, pull ups or swim diapers allowed in the pool.
 - Arm floats and life vests are OK only if an adult is within arm's reach.
 - Noodles and "soaker balls" are OK.
 - No kick boards. No floats. No hard toys or water guns.
 - No hanging on lane lines or steps in walking section.
 - No hanging on ladders or steps.
 - Swimmers under 16 should not be in the lap lanes.
 - Jump only in shallow swim area or diving well. No diving in shallow water.
 - Long hair must be tied up.
 - Children must be with an adult in the walking section of the pool. Pool staff may ask you to remove children temporarily on a busy day.

Pool Functions

- Any use of the pool other than specified hours must be arranged via the pool party email hmpoolparty2018@gmail.com or by picking up a pool party packet at the Pool Manager's office.
 - Parties are subject to terms of a Pool Reservation Contract.
 - Parties must be scheduled at least 2 weeks in advance. During normal pool hours parties are limited to 12 participants. Guest fees apply.
 - Pool volleyball and/or games available 6:30-7:15 p.m. on weekend nights.
 - Pool may close at 5:00 p.m. for Pool Committee events.

Emergency Closing

- Thunder: pool is emptied for 20-minute intervals starting with the last thunder heard. One long whistle blast clears the pool.
 - Lightning: pool is closed and emptied. Residents and their guests may return to the pool 30 minutes after the storm has passed. Check the website for updates on pool closings.
