

DVD Player

DVD Players must be plugged into a Television to play. Not all TV's will accommodate a DVD Player. You must follow the directions that came with the DVD Player and also with the TV. You will need the DVD Player Remote and also the Remote that came with the TV.

Check the following:

- 1) Is the DVD Player plugged into the TV? If not, it must be.
- 2) Do you have the DVD Player Remote? If not, you must have it to operate the DVD Player.
- 3) Read the original instructions that came with the DVD Player. Check to be sure all instructions have been followed.

If the DVD Player is properly plugged into the Television and still will not play, then very likely the TV is not on the right HDMI Port or Input for the DVD Player.

Changing the HDMI Port or Input:

Turn the TV On

On the FiOS Remote:

Depress the small bottom left side button (On the LBR, depress the 0 on the Keypad)

A list will show on the TV screen. Every TV is different and the list will depend on the TV itself.

Depress the small bottom left side button to change HDMI Ports until you find the correct Input for the DVD Player.

Depress the XXXXX button

To Return the TV to the proper HDMI Port or Input for the television, follow the directions above until the TV comes on.
