Experience the excitement of immigrants as we visit the new Statue of Liberty Museum and the National Immigration Museum. Opened in May, the Statue of Liberty Museum contains three interactive galleries that tell the statue's history. See sweeping views of the iconic statue and NY harbor from the roof deck. An optional tour of the statue pedestal is included. On Ellis Island, go through the immigrant registration process and view the Wall of Honor. Audio headsets are provided at each site. Lunch is on your own at the destination. Mandatory security screening and photo ID are required to board ferries. Dress according to the weather and wear comfortable walking shoes. Deadline to sign up is September 17. We will be returning to Hershey's Mill at 7:30pm, and we will plan on a short rest stop both on the way down and back.

NOTES:

1. Prior to making payment, anyone who wishes to participate in a bus trip must first call the contact person to ensure that there is still room on the bus.
2. All bus riders must be age 18 or older unless otherwise noted in the trip write-up.
3. Trip payment checks should be made payable to "HERSHEY'S MILL HOA", sealed in an envelope (noting trip name and date), and placed in the maroon "Customer Service" mailbox next to the Security Center in the exit lane at the Main Gate.
4. Refunds are only granted if (1) the trip is canceled, or (2) the trip has a wait list from which another passenger can fill the vacated spot.
5. Bus leaves promptly at the scheduled Leave Time. Please plan to arrive 10 minutes early.
