We have a recently renovated facility in the Community Center and invite you to come in for a visit to review our collection of over 3000 books. Every month we purchase new fiction and non-fiction best sellers chosen with the help of various literary review sources. We continue to increase our collection of LARGE PRINT books with new ones added regularly. In addition, we have a large number of audio books, DVD's and jigsaw puzzles.

We subscribe to the *Wall Street Journal* and *Consumer Reports*. Please stop in, have a seat and read these publications which can't leave the library.

We also have a service for anyone who is unable to visit the library. "Ambassadors" will deliver books, audio CDs/DVDs or puzzles to anyone who requests them.

The Library is staffed by an active group of Volunteers. If you are interested in becoming a volunteer please contact our Volunteer Chair for more information.

From time to time we have a used book sale and are happy to accept donations of your gently used books and puzzles, as well as audio books & DVDs. There is always a cart outside the library entrance where we sell discarded library books for \$1 each.

Our <u>Friends of the Library</u> program helps to cover operating expenses and assists in financing some of our programs such as guest speakers. The annual donation to become a "Friend" is \$10.00 or more per person.
