Real Estate Update for Robynwood and the Mill: Mariangela Hlis, Weichert Realtors West Chester, Source Bright MLS

Currently there are 10 "Active" listings in Hershey's Mill. Prices are ranging from \$294,000 to \$598,000. There are 7 homes "Under Contract/Pending" and 9 homes have settled in the last 30 days. Settled homes range from \$246,000 to \$602,700.

Currently, 1314 is on the market for \$505,000. 1317 Robynwood is "Pending" and will settle on July 9, 2021.

Inventory in the Mill is extremely low but increasing. It is definitely a Seller's market.

Other Information

Dryer Vents-As a reminder, it is recommended that a family of 4 or more have their dryer vents cleaned annually. A family of less than 4, every two years.
