

# Hershey's Mill Sports Committee Meeting 8/22/2022@1:00 via Zoom

**Attendees**: MaryAnn DeFalco, Bob Gottschall, Jack Hamilton, Sherry Kane, George Madden, Lynn Mander, Dave Nagurney, Jack Nilon

**Meeting Minutes Approval:** Meeting minutes from 7/18/22 were approved and will be posted on the web.

**Treasurer's report**: Lynn reported that as of 7/31/22, the HMS checkbook balance was \$16,593.57 which included the bowling account with YTD income of \$3,097 and expenses of \$4,198.

#### **Old Business:**

- <u>Labor Day Planning</u> MaryAnn reported that Lynn had received 37 reservations so far. Plans are in place for an exciting occasion including approximately 160 Long Island hot dogs. Another highlight of the event will be the first annual Bake Contest. It was agreed that prizes will be awarded to the top 3 selections: a \$25 Wawa gift certificate to the winner; a \$15 Wawa gift certificate to the 2<sup>nd</sup> place finisher and a Hershey's Mill Sports Hat to the 3<sup>rd</sup> place finisher. Jack will ice the water, some of which was donated by Wagner Real Estate and put it in 4 coolers strategically located including one at the pool.
- Pig Roast Planning Sherry gave an update on the second annual Pig Roast which will happen on 9/16 from 5:00 to 7:00 PM rain or shine. In the event of inclement weather, the food will be packaged in containers. Water will be provided by Wagner Real Estate. Jack will ice the water in coolers. Attendees will have a choice of pork or chicken (with sides). DR Gabe donated \$500 and will be provided signage. Two teenage servers were approved. Residents will be asked to bring a dessert to share. The cost was computed to be \$19.25 per person. It was agreed upon that we would charge \$22 per person to allow for some headroom in expenses. A notice will be sent to all HM residents to sign up between 8/24/22 9:00 thru 8/31/22.

- Assignments: Lynn meet Miller at 6:00 at the Cove, Dave table set up, Jack waters and ice, Trash to dumpster all, Sherry/Carroll Thompson receiving.
- <u>Dr. Gabe</u> October Stretch Seminar and Clinic Sherry reported that it will occur in early October. The particulars will be reviewed at the next HMSC meeting.
- Sports Leaders Free Hot Dogs on Labor Day It was agreed that all the sports leaders will be given a ticket for a free hot dog on Labor Day.

#### **New Business:**

- <u>Ambassadors</u> It was agreed that the ambassadors are no longer needed tp promote the sports program. Dave will write a letter to the Village presidents announcing the decision. If agreed, a letter will be sent to the Ambassadors thanking them. The By-Laws will need to be updated to reflect this decision.
- <u>Hard Name Tags</u> It was agreed that if any resident would like to purchase a hard name tag, they may do so by contacting the source (in Berwyn) directly. The price is \$10.00 each. Lynn to confirm logistics with the vendor and directions on how to order. Once the details are confirmed, they will be sent to all HM residents.
- <u>Pedego E-Bike Fall Event</u> Jack reported that everything is in place for the return of the Pedego E-Bike demonstration and resident rides (after a waiver is signed). The event will occur October 15 from 1:00 to 4:00 PM. Rain date is October 22.
- Napkins, Plates and Utensils It was agreed that the HMSC will purchase \$75 worth of napkins, plates and utensils for use at all sports events. Mary Ann and Bob will conduct an inventory and set up a periodic review to replace supplies as needed.
- <u>All Residents Meeting in November</u> Logistics will be discussed at the next HMSC meeting.
- Next HMSC Meeting Date Because the Bocce finals will be played on September 19, it was agreed that the next HMSC meeting will be changed to September 26.
- <u>East Lawn Project</u> Jack Nilon reported that the East Lawn Project is now scheduled to begin in late September.
- <u>Tennis Court Maintenance</u> Jack Nilon stated that the Master Association is looking into a pressure washing technique to clean the tennis courts.
