Meeting Minutes Approval: Meeting minutes from 9/26/22 were approved and will be posted on the web.

Treasurer's report: As of 10/17/22, Lynn reported the HMS checkbook balance was \$18,783.46 which included the bowling balance of \$490.13.

Old Business:

- All Residents Meeting Agenda Review -- Dave reviewed the agenda which will include: opening remarks; an introduction of the committee members; remarks by Jack Nilon (sports liaison to the MA Board); communication information from Sherry; East Lawn project update from Bob; and sports update from all the sports leaders. Mary Ann will have 100 Sports brochures and 50 color copies of the agenda printed at Staples for distribution at the meeting.
- Dr. Gabe Recap and Future Seminars – Sherry reported that Dr. Gabe's early October seminar on the "Science of Stretch" and clinics that followed were both well-attended and a huge success. So much so that Dr. Gabe will return for a sixth time in January/March (subject to be determined).
- Name Tag Update – Lynn said she has turned over everything to Carroll Thompson. It was agreed that we will kick this off in January with helpers for Carroll. Sherry will do communications, Dave will drop off and pick up in Berwyn, Dawn K will help distribute the tags and Jack will be the money man.
- East Lawn Project Update – Bob reported that the project is now expected to be completed in the Spring.
- Supplies Update/Letter to Leaders – Dave will ask Mary Ann to send a letter to the sports leaders regarding supplies. The letter will detail what the

HMSC will do for the leaders and what the leaders will be expected to do as well.

- Stipend Guidelines Discussion – The HMSC has voted to provide a stipend of \$100 to each sports leader next year. The purpose is to fund promotional activities for each sport. No prior approval by the HMSC is required. Sales receipts (up to \$100) are to be submitted to the HMSC Treasury for reimbursement. This is a trial program and if successful will be repeated in years to come.
- Community Open House Day Update – Sherry and George reported that many individuals who may be interested in someday purchasing a home in Hershey's Mill attended the event. Sports were on the mind of many. Sherry & Gorge told them of the many sports activities available to residents. And all who attended were given a Sports brochure. Sherry suggested to buy a tablecloth with HMS logo for future Open Houses.
- Pedego E-Bike Fall Event – Jack reported that the October 15 Pedego E-Bike demonstration and resident rides (after signing a waiver) was a big success. A number of enthusiastic residents were happy to learn about E-Bikes and take them for a spin. The Pedego representatives will return again for a third time next Spring.
