



Hershey's Mill Sports Committee Meeting Minutes
4/17/2023 @ 1:00 Via Zoom

Meeting Minutes Approval: Meeting minutes from 3/20/23 were approved and will be posted on the web.

Treasurer's report: Lynn reported that as of March 31, the HMS checking account balance was \$16,387.30 and the bowling checking account balance was \$548.37 – a grand total of \$16,935.67.

Old Business:

- Fund Raiser By-Laws Update – The second revision of a letter written by Dave and previously sent to the sports committee members was reviewed and approved unanimously. Highlights include: All sports may run a 50/50 Fund Raiser; no other form of Fund Raiser will be permitted; half of the funds collected go to the winner and the proceeds (50% of funds collected) will go into the HMSC checking account to be earmarked for that sport and used later for promotional events and/or supplies, decorations, prizes, food and non-alcoholic beverages for social events; there will a one year trial period. Sherry and George Madden will present the letter to the Documents Committee for their review.
- Medicare Gym Coverage - Sherry reported that the HMMA has taken the lead on this, and she has sent an email blast with complete information to all Hershey's Mill residents.
- CPR HMCTV Foundation Grant –The current plan is to have 4 CPR classes of 12 participants. The current Grant money covers 30 people at no charge. We will wait until after the May classes are complete and if a Fall class is needed before we seek additional Grant funds. Barb Trimble will

oversee each class, Mary Ann DeFalco will assist, and Sherry will email an informational blast to all residents.

- Water Bottle Donations – Sherry reported that Wagner/Compass will donate water bottles for the July 4th sports festivities and the Pig Roast. Jack is working on a sponsor for the water bottles for Memorial Day and Labor Day sports festivities.
- All Residents Spring Meeting Agenda – The agenda for the April 24 meeting (from 10:00 AM to noon) was prepared by Dave. It was reviewed and approved. The meeting will be in person at the Community Center and Zoomed.
- Community Open House Day – Lynn and Mary Ann will represent the Sports Committee at the May 21 event greeting visitors and directing them to the various sports venues.
- Memorial Day Sports Festivities – Maryann outlined the plans for Memorial Day which will again include her now-famous Long Island Hot Dogs.
- Feather Flags – Sherry discussed the many benefits of two Feather Flags. The flags can be a fun way of informing residents of sports festivities. The price will be \$300 each. A vote was taken and approved unanimously.

New Business:

- July 4th Date – July 4th falls on a Tuesday, so a discussion ensued regarding possibly changing the sports festivities to Monday, July 3rd. It was unanimously agreed to have the celebration on Tuesday, the 4th.
- Pool Activities – Dave will email a list of the pool activities for the 2023 season to all committee members.
- Pedego - E-Bike Demonstration at Hershey's Mill – Jack reported that while it looks like a good possibility, a final decision has not yet been made by the Pedego owners. If it happens, a Saturday in mid-June is the likely date. Only the \$250 subscription fee will be accessed.

Facilities:

- Paddle Lights and Timer – It appears that no final decision has been made on either. Since the Paddle season will officially end later this month, there is a good possibility that no decision will be made until the Fall.
- East Lawn work will resume soon.
- Tennis courts were power washed and re-groomed with new sand and ready for the season.
